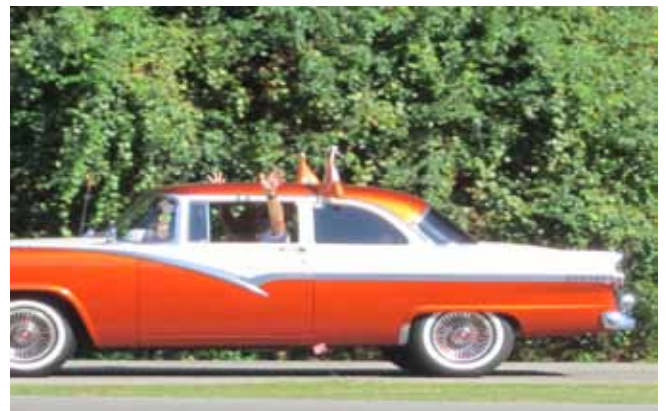
Dietary Staff Appreciation
